



Softball Division – Summer Season 2026/27

INFORMATION & REGISTRATION PROCESS

To Carine Softball Players,

Welcome to returning players and new players to Carine Cats Softball and to the 2026/27 summer season of softball. We love to see you all out and enjoying community sport.

Please note: Most of our comms and **ALL** our team management is conducted via [Stack Team App](#). We highly recommend you download the app, where you can chat with teammates, see team and club events, RSVP to games and much more!

Carine Club Fees

Your Carine Softball club registration fees include:

- PSL Team nomination and umpiring fees:
 - We roll umpiring fees into the registration fees to make collection and redistribution easier for the Team Managers. This is a fairer approach, as all players pay the same amount regardless of affecting factors such as team size and home/away fixturing.
- Club running costs (including but not limited to):
 - CCBC Management Fees – overarching insurance and ball club running costs
 - Clubroom leasing – payable to City of Stirling
 - Ground hire – payable to City of Stirling
 - Lighting – payable to City of Stirling
 - Field maintenance – for paint, cutout + base maintenance
 - Equipment – new balls, bats, catchers gear, etc
 - Season windups – venue hire and inclusions
 - Trophies & Awards
 - Scorebooks

The 26/27 Summer club registration fees are:

Juniors competition – \$230

Seniors competition (18 years and over) – \$345

State League competition – \$240

Summer Vets competition – \$285 (Players from 40 years of age or older)

The discounted combination club fees are:

Juniors also playing in Seniors – \$430

Seniors also playing in State League – \$480

Payment plans are on offer within the registration system. These incur a \$10 fee to cover the additional transaction fees.

Softball Australia Capitation fee

A capitation fee (covering insurance and association fees) is set by and to be paid to Softball Australia, as part of the registration process. This is paid once a year and covers you even if you play across two seasons, for example, men playing summer vets and the subsequent regular winter season competitions.

2026/27 capitation fees are:

Seniors - \$65 Juniors - \$36.25 ***NEW*** ADF Seniors - \$21.53

(Officials are a \$0 no-cost option this year)

***NEW* REGISTRATION PROCESS**

We have moved to a single-step registration process!

All registrations and fees (Association and Club) will be completed on [RevSport](#).

There are MANY different registration types available (including some with payment plans). Please ensure you read them carefully and select the correct type.

If you can't find the correct registration type for you, please [contact our registrar](#) to arrange an alternative registration method (including “Pay-per-Play” options).

By registering with Carine Cats, you are agreeing to abide by our [Code of Conduct](#).

PAY-per-PLAY OPTION EXPLAINED

The PAY-per-PLAY registration option is only entered into with agreement by the [Softball Registrar](#).

- For players unsure how many games they might play or will only be available on a “fill-in” basis.
- **The “PAY-per-PLAY” rate is \$25/game.** As with a standard full season player, this fixed rate also allows for a proportion of umpire fees, team registration fees, club running costs and admin.
- Users should discuss with the registrar their expected number of games and pay in advance wherever possible. Adjustments +/- will be consolidated at the end of season.
- If your circumstances change and you end up playing more games than expected, your fee will be capped at the regular fee for your division.

KIDSPORT

The [KidSport program](#) assistance is up to \$500 per eligible child per calendar year.

KidSport enables eligible Western Australian children aged 5 to 18 years, whose parents hold a valid Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, to participate in community sport by offering them financial assistance of up to \$500 per calendar year towards club fees. The KidSport payment goes direct to the registered KidSport Club participating in the project through their Local Government. PRE-SEASON TRAINING/GRADING

Team Nominations for the summer season are lodged in early September. Pre-season training/grading is **COMPULSORY** for Juniors and detailed below. Seniors wishing to be considered for playing in Div 1 to Div 3 should attend **at least one of the senior pre-season training sessions** detailed below.

Exact times and locations are TBA. Keep an eye on the [Stack Team App](#) for details.

JUNIORS:

A "Come and Try" day will be held in conjunction with Tee Ball, to be held in August.

Additional junior training will be held at **Birralee Upper Oval** (cnr Beatrice St and Shaw Ave, Innaloo). These will incorporate "Transition to Softball" sessions for Tee Ball players entering softball for first time and sessions for players wanting to improve their skills. These are expected to be held over August & September.

Spring training continues after Team Allocation and are expected to be held over September & October.

SENIORS:

Pre-season training/grading for seniors will be at **Birralee Upper Oval** (cnr Beatrice Street and Shaw Avenue, Innaloo) and are expected to be held in August.

Players are to wear appropriate sports wear (especially if cold and wet) and bring a water bottle, hat, jacket, your GLOVE and your helmet (if you own one).

Any grading request to be in writing to [Softball Registrar](#) and will be referred to grading group for consideration and will be dependent on individual circumstances.

ORIENTATION EVENING

To be held in **SEPTEMBER 2026** @ Birralee Club rooms, cnr Beatrice Street and Shaw Road, Innaloo.

Coaches, Managers and Scorers are requested to attend so that specific information on the upcoming season can be distributed and explained.

OTHER SESSIONS

Specialised sessions in pitching, catching will be advised in due course. Scoring Clinics will be scheduled prior to season commencement for new scorers or those wishing to brush up on their skills. Softball WA usually runs a scoring clinic before season start also. Coaching clinics are also available online.

UNIFORMS

Uniforms will be available to purchase (if required) for the upcoming season.

Juniors – Playing tops will be provided by the Softball Division. Players to provide their own black pants, or chippers – no leggings. Socks and undershirts will be black. Caps will be black with "CC" logo.

Seniors – Playing tops are to be purchased as necessary. Pants or chippers will be black.

Undershirts/compression garments will be black and playing socks will be black. Cap or visor will be black with "CC" logo.

Further information on uniforms will be forwarded to registered players at a later date.

SUPPORT CREW

Teams need support in the areas of coaching, scoring and a manager. If you are interested in one of these roles, please advise the Softball Registrar.
